<b>Intent</b>	At OWE, it is our intention that all children are given the opportunity to become an artist in their own right. We want our children to develop a love for art and capture their imagination by inspiring them to create their own masterpieces based on work by famous craftspeople and artists. To create the best work, we want our children to explore and create with a variety of media and to become more confident in the different aspects of art- sculpture, paintwork, drawing, collaging, textiles and printing. We want to see a true progression of skills which are exemplified in UKS2. This feeds into our curriculum intent driving our values of Respect for the work of artists and Resilience to continually build skills and knowledge.
<b>Implement</b>	At OWE, we ensure we offer a variety of artistic opportunities in which all children can participate. Using a curriculum inspired by Access Art, we offer a wide range of media for the children to explore to create, develop and refine their techniques. We record our personal art journeys in art journals before creating final pieces. It is important we allow children the chance to practice skills, build resilience and refine their techniques to be able to achieve the best outcomes. In classes, we will focus on particular artists and craftspeople linked to our topics to inspire our children.
<b>Impact</b>	Our children will appreciate and respect the work of a multitude of artists and understand the motivation behind the work of artists. They will feel confident to explore media and develop their skills across the key stages. It is important that our children recognise the beauty, emotion and subjectiveness of art and that it is ok to have their own opinions about artworks and have the ability to discuss and critique art with confidence and using vocabulary to evaluate artwork thoughtfully and respectfully, using appropriate artistic language .
